

Jordan for the 1st of May Weekend

VISITING: AMMAN, KERAK, PETRA, MOUNT NEBO, DEAD SEA, MADABA AND AMMAN

Tuesday 28th April: Meet the Tour Leader at Malta International Airport at 0700hrs for check-in on your direct Ryan Air flight to Amman departing at 0850hrs. Upon arrival at Amman airport, your local representative and English-speaking guide will be waiting for you to assist you with the visa procedures. Soon afterwards, proceed to your private airconditioned coach transfer towards Petra, but not before a visit to the fantastic crusader stronghold at Kerak (emtrance fee included). Once at Petra, check-in, room and allocation will follow soon before dinner (optional) and overnight.

Wednesday 29th April: Soon after your breakfast, join your fellow group members, for the highlight of this tour: explore Petra (entrance fee included) and all of its facades. One of the Seven Wonders of the World, this "rose-red city half as old as time" was hewn from sandstone thousands of years ago. Enter by the Siq and visit the Treasury, Street of Facades, Theatre and the Colonnaded Street amongst numerous other impressive buildings and sites. Free time for lunch (not included) inside the site and in the afternoon, return to your hotel for your deserved rest. Later re-join the group and complete your Petra experience with the Petra by Night Show: a magical way to experience this marvellous attraction lit with over 1,500 candles. Dinner (optional) will be served at the Al Qantarah Restaurant.

Thursday 30th April: After breakfast and checkout, head North towards the Dead Sea, but not before an interesting visit of Mount Nebo (entrance fee included), from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Visit the Sanctuary: the memorial of Moses, the presumed site of his death and burial place, and a centre for pilgrimages since earliest Christian times. Lunch will be served at the Mazayen Restaurant in Mount Nebo (not included) and later continue your way towards your 4* Hotel on the Dead Sea in time for check-in, room allocation, dinner (optional) and overnight.



Friday 1st May - PUBLIC HOLIDAY: Today, join your tour leader for a visit to the market town of Madaba, best known for a collection of Byzantine-era mosaics. The most famous of which is the map on the floor of St George's Church. Later continue your travel towards Amman: Jordan's capital city, and specifically towards the old citadel made famous by the new Cold Play Live shows. After lunch (extra), you will also visit the famous Roman Theatre (entrance fee included) in the heart of this cosmopolitan town before your return to the hotel for your deserved free time. Enjoy floating at the hotel private beach, and feel how smooth and clean your skin feels after you cover yourself up, in the black mud found along the foreshore. Alternatively, you can also visit the hotel spa centre for some pampering treatments before dinner (optional) and overnight.

Saturday 2nd May: After early breakfast and checkout, head towards Amman's International Airport for your flight back to Malta departing at 1030hrs.
